

ORDINANCE NO. 1-72.22

ORDINANCE NO. 1-72.22 amending Ordinance No. 1-68.18 and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HARTVILLE, STARK COUNTY, OHIO.

SECTION 1: That SECTION 3, Subsection E, Paragraph 6 of Ordinance No. 1-68.18 which reads as follows:

“6. Gains from involuntary conversion, cancellation of indebtedness, interest on Federal obligations, items of income already taxed by the State of Ohio, and income of a decedent’s estate during the period of administration (except such income from the operation of a business).”

be amended to read as follows:

“6. Gains from involuntary conversion, cancellation of indebtedness, interest on Federal obligations, items of income already taxed by the State of Ohio which the Village is specifically prohibited from taxing, and income of a decedent’s estate during the period of administration (except such income form the operation of a business).”

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and necessary for the collection of municipal revenues and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and at the earliest date permitted by law.
